

Trout River Traders' Reserve Wine List

White

Patz & Hall Chardonnay 2005, Napa Valley

Exhibits aromas of orange blossom and toasted brioche interwoven with hints of lemon zest and ginger snap. The palate is filled with multi-faceted tones of fresh nectarine, ripe pear and touches of vanilla.

La Chablisienne Les Clos Grand Cru 2001, Chablis

This wine is a beautiful white Burgundy. Packed with fresh lemon, honey and ripe fruit, in a clean and full-bodied package that is deeply satisfying.

Red

Paradigm Winery Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley

This complex wine offers a mix of ripe currant, black cherry and plum with accents of ample vanilla bean and mocha-scented oak. There are firm tannins that are ripe and balanced delivering an elegant mouth-feel.

Château Palmer "Alter Ego" 2002, Margaux

The nose is fresh with pretty currants and berry aromas. This full-bodied wine has silky tannins and an attractive vanilla and berry aftertaste.

Vision Cellars "Rosella's Vinyard" Pinot Noir 2003, Santa Lucia Highlands

Ripe cherry, plum and blackberry fruit is fresh and enticing paired with a supple texture, with a dusty berry, spice and nutmeg note on the finish. This Pinot Noir is polished and elegant.

Patrick Leseq Selections "Bargeton" Châteauneuf-du-Pape 2004

Elegant wine displaying a dark color, and abundant qualities of black fruits, a touch of herbs, and sweet licorice.

Azelia Barolo 2001

Bright blackberry and cherry aromas with hints of minerals. Full-bodied, with silky tannins and a long, caressing finish. Extremely well crafted.

Dutschke "St. Jakobi" Shiraz 2003, Barossa Valley

Supple for a big wine, weaving it's plum blackberry, caramel and spice character into a cohesive whole, letting the flavors liger against fine tannins
