**Selbach, "Fish Label" Dry Riesling 2005, Mosel-Saar-Ruwer, Germany**  
*Shows satisfying weight, minerality and stylishness. It's really dry, but with no sharp edges.*

**McManis Viognier 2005, River Junction**  
*Big and fruit forward in pineapples, apricots and peaches with a good spine of acidity and a nice, creamy texture, dry and well-balanced.*

**La Puerta Torrontes 2005, La Rioja, Argentina**  
*Extremely aromatic with scents of mineral, rose petal, spice and exotic fruit. Great fruit with a bone dry finish.*

**Honig Sauvignon Blanc 2005, Napa Valley**  
*Clean and refreshing with vibrant lime, mineral, honeydew and fragrant sweet pea flavors that linger on the finish.*

**Iron Horse Estate Chardonnay 2003, Sonoma Coast/Green Valley**  
*Multi-layers of complexity, finesse and bright, zingy flavors.*

**Yorkville Cellars Sauvignon Blanc 2005, Mendocino- ORGANIC**  
*Not overly grassy. Highlighted flavors of pear, grapefruit zest and lemon thyme.*
